

SOLID – A series by Mattias Stenberg

Celebrating craftsmanship, craftspeople and the materials used to create a glass object that feels both unexpected and obvious at the same time was the aim of the Solid series. The thickness of the clear glass is the main event and is emphasised by being enclosed in outer and inner "shells" of colour and finishes. The variations of the inner bowl should bear witness to the presence of handcrafting in the creation of the object.







SEPTUM – A series by Mattias Stenberg Septum means a "chamber wall", something that divides two volumes from each other – just like the wall that divides our heart into a right and left half. Septum vases are designed to maintain a simple, controlled outer contour, while the wall that divides the upper and lower half is allowed to live its own life, showcasing the natural dynamics of the glass.

Glass artist Asa Jungnelius.

Since her debut with Kosta Boda in 2007, Åsa Jungnelius has explored distinctive female objects. She has played with lipstick and nail polish bottles and has more than once amazed and maybe embarrassed us with her expressions of male and female gender. She has carved out her own, totally unique territory among glass designers.

Åsa Jungnelius is an artist (MFA) and lecturer at Konstfack, the University College of Arts, Crafts and Design, based in Stockholm and Månsamåla in the southern Swedish province of Småland. She is also currently working on Snäckan (The Seashell), a public artwork in the new Hagastaden underground train station in Stockholm, which is a tribute to motherhood. Jungnelius is also the artistic director of the artistdriven project ResidenceInNature. Many of her works feature in private and public collections throughout Sweden. She has achieved a great deal of success in art institutions and won a number of awards and stipends. In collaboration with the LAST studio, she has designed parts of the tailor-made interior of the Nationalmuseum in Stockholm.



"I love to work with a theme. Glass offers possibilities that no other material can. It's like the outpouring from a volcano where the glowing mass is rapidly transformed into ice. The challenge is to capture the look and the light at just the right moment to allow the glass to reveal its secrets."

Bertil Vallien is Sweden's most famous glass artist and designer. He has won numerous awards and is richly represented in museums throughout the world. Vallien works with a mystical, dreamlike and symbolic world of motifs and carries out what he himself describes as an investigation, in close collaboration with his colleagues, many of whom he has worked closely with for decades. Vallien is most famous as an expert sand caster. His solid boats in a deep blue colour are part of modern glass history. He is also the creator of Château, one of Kosta Boda's most popular glassware series.

"My creativity is based on the circle of life. I want to design glass you can feel – glass that speaks to all of the senses – to use refraction and the light – to create pictures and tell stories. I am driven by an inner search, in which curiosity, mysticism and mythology are important elements. It is the glass itself – the living melt – that is my constant companion."

A tireless glass artist with boundless imagination and a passion for narrative that he gives free rein to in both utility and art glass, Kjell Engman is inspired by the animal kingdom and the world of music. He often works on larger installations in which he also uses elements such as sound and light. Kjell Engman is frequently commissioned to create public installations both in Sweden and abroad.

"To me the smeltery is where the creation occurs. This is where the glass is born, shaped and comes alive. I want to respect the life of the glass by working with it and not against it. I try to follow the melt – the sheer power of the glass that can't be restrained – yet at the same time see simplicity and subtlety."

Anna Ehrner is an experimental, minimalistic artist with a style distinguished by simple yet powerful designs and an ability to achieve great impact with colour by using it in subtle ways. Veils of colour inside the glass have become a distinctive feature for Ehrner, as has the coiled glass that features in the Basket and Energy series. Anna is behind the creation of many best-sellers, such as Line glasses, the Contrast series of bowls and more recently Basket and Cupcake.

"The melt glowing in the furnace is what inspires me to new discoveries. Every gather fills me with the desire to give new expression to the magic of glass. I want to make a piece of glass into the bearer of light, the ocean and air. I want to create a place where light, warmth and sensuality can live."

Very few people have such a depth of feeling for the glass melt as Göran Wärff, who has always been keen to nurture the expertise involved in the classic traditions of glassblowing and cutting. The play of light in the volume of clear glass and the endless optical phenomena that occur when glass refracts light are constantly recurring themes in Wärff's products. As well as glass itself, nature and the play of light in the landscape are his other main sources of inspiration.
